The Our Views, Our Voices training program is a peer-led training program to equip people living with NCDs with skills to become effective spokespersons, share their lived experiences to amplify the [Ghana Advocacy Agenda of People Living with NCDs](#) at all levels and build a powerful narrative on NCDs.

Under the initiative, the Ghana NCD Alliance is hosting an Our Views, Our Voices training session in four regions to provide an opportunity for those committed to making a difference for people living with NCDs and are keen to take their advocacy skills to the next level through joining the national network of people living with NCDs, a establishing a community network of people living with NCDs and identify opportunities to share their lived experiences to amplify the [Ghana Advocacy Agenda of People Living with NCDs](#) at the community levels.

In the selection of the overall participants, the Ghana NCD Alliance ensure a gender-balanced group representing different NCD conditions and the experiences and diversity of the NCD community.
